The Adapted Sports Clinic is a great way to get ready for the fun competition of the Games. The Clinic helps to introduce the activities and competitive events to new athletes and serves as Games training preparation for all athletes.

Athletes will learn about and participate in field events, mini golf, basketball shooting, target shoot, slalom, wheelchair and ambulatory slalom and other activities.
